Colder NS2 Series quick disconnect couplings offer hose barb terminations and are available for tubing in ½" (3.2mm) and ½" (6.4mm) ID. Configurations include pipe thread, in-line and panel mount. The ferruless compression terminations connect to ½" OD (6.4mm) and 0.17" ID (4.3mm) semi-rigid tubing. Pressure ranges from vacuum to 45 psi (3.1 bar), and operating temperatures range from 32° F (0° C) to 120° F (49° C).
